Looking After Your Sofa

General Care

Keeping your sofa in tip-top shape doesn't have to be a hassle. A quick weekly vacuum using the upholstery attachment is a simple yet effective way to keep dust from settling in, especially on armrests & cushions.

To keep your sofa's structure in great shape, avoid sitting on the armrests or the edges of the cushions. Switch up your seating spots to help distribute wear more evenly. Got pets? Consider popping a throw over the sofa to protect against claws & shedding – plus it adds an extra cosy touch!

Spot Cleaning

If you have a spill, act fast! Gently blot the area with a clean, dry cloth to absorb moisture. Avoid rubbing - this can push the spill deeper into the fabric. We advise against adding water or cleaners, as they could leave marks or discolouration. For anything tricky, it's best to call in the pros.



Fabric Upholstery Care

Fabric sofas add a lovely warmth & softness to your space – and with a little regular care, they'll stay looking their best. For day-to-day upkeep, a gentle dusting with a soft brush or upholstery attachment does the trick. Avoid direct sunlight to prevent fading, and try to keep it away from radiators or heaters, which may dry out the fibres.

Leather Upholstery Care

Leather has a timeless look and can age beautifully. A weekly dust with a soft cloth will keep it clean, and every few months, give it a gentle wipe with lukewarm water & mild soap, using a slightly damp cloth. Be sure not to soak the leather. Simply wipe it, then let it air-dry naturally.

Faux Leather Care

Faux leather is both stylish & easy to maintain. Dust it regularly with a soft, dry cloth, and wipe it down occasionally with a damp cloth to keep it looking sleek. Avoid harsh chemicals as they can damage the surface. Keep out of direct sunlight to prevent cracking and fading.

Linen Upholstery Care

Linen has a beautifully airy, natural feel & benefits from gentle handling.

Vacuum it weekly using an upholstery nozzle to clear dust.

If you have any spills, blot right away with a dry, absorbent cloth.

Avoid direct sunlight to maintain its colour. For spot cleaning, it's best to consult a professional to prevent shrinkage or colour changes.

Velvet Upholstery Care

Velvet upholstery can show pressure marks, which is completely natural. To restore the softness, brush gently with a soft brush. Keep out of direct sunlight, as it's prone to fading, so choose a shady spot.

Cushion Care

Feather & fibre-filled cushions bring comfort, but they do need a bit of love. Plump & rotate regularly to help them keep their shape & softness. For removable covers, a quick spot clean or occasional professional clean will keep them looking their best.

Wood & Metal Sofa Legs

Dust occasionally with a soft, dry cloth. For wood, avoid solvent-based cleaners, as they can damage the finish. Metal can be wiped with a damp cloth, but dry thoroughly.
