

Pull up a chair...and learn how to make it last.

From upholstered comfort to sleek swivel styles, your dining chairs deserve a little love. Here's how to keep them looking sharp, feeling fresh and ready for every meal.

Everyday Cleaning Tips Simple habits go a long way...

Dust Weekly: Use a soft, dry cloth or microfibre duster to remove crumbs and surface dust.

Wipe Gently: For hard surfaces like wood or metal, use a damp cloth with mild soap. Dry immediately.

Avoid Harsh Cleaners: Skip anything with bleach, ammonia or abrasives - they can damage finishes and fabrics.

Upholstered Dining Chairs Soft, stylish and comfortable - these need a gentle touch.

Vacuum Weekly: Use a soft brush attachment to lift dust & crumbs from seams and surfaces.

Spot Clean Quickly: Dab spills with a clean, dry cloth. Never rub, it can spread the stain or damage the fibres.

Avoid Saturation: Never soak the fabric, moisture can seep into the padding and cause mould.

Sunlight Tip: Keep out of direct sunlight to prevent fading.

Faux Leather Dining Chairs

Sleek and easy to clean, but sensitive to strong chemicals.

Daily Wipe: Use a soft cloth with warm water and mild soap.

Read on...

Deep Clean: For tougher marks, use a faux leather-safe cleaner.

Avoid: Alcohol-based products, they can dry out and crack the surface.

Shine Tip: Buff with a dry cloth to restore the finish.

Swivel Dining Chairs

Functional and fun – just keep them moving smoothly.

Clean the Base: Wipe metal or coated bases with mild soap and water. Dry thoroughly.

Check the Mechanism: Every few months, inspect the swivel for dust or debris.

Lubrication Tip: If needed, use a silicone-based lubricant - never oil-based, which can attract grime & gum up the mechanism.

Wooden Legs & Frames

Use a dry/slightly damp, soft cloth to dust & wipe. Avoid excessive water & wipe the area completely dry immediately to prevent damage.

Homes with Pets & Kids

For busy households, a few extra habits help.

Use Covers or Throws:

Removable covers protect against spills, fur & sticky fingers.

Vacuum Often: Pet hair & crumbs settle fast, especially on fabric.

Lifting, Moving & Storage

Protect your dining chairs when shifting or storing.

Lift, Don't Drag: Always lift chairs from the base (not the backrest) to avoid strain or loosening joints.

Use Two Hands: Especially for swivel or upholstered styles, which may be heavier or more delicate.

Rotate Chairs: Swap positions occasionally to even out wear across seats and fabrics.

Storage Tip: Store in a dry, ventilated space. Cover with breathable fabric (not plastic) to prevent moisture build-up.

Stacking Caution: Only stack chairs designed for it - look for flat seats and reinforced legs. Improper stacking can warp legs or scratch finishes.

Time to Dine

Now pull up a chair & dig in. With the right care, your dining chairs will stay stylish, sturdy and comfortable - meal after meal.
